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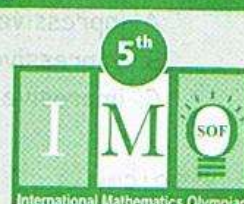

Oceans and seas are large areas of water on the surface of the earth. But they are different from each other too. Oceans are enormous when compared to seas: they contain more water than seas.
