Grades IX AND X Students Attend Pariksha Pe Charcha 2026 at ICC

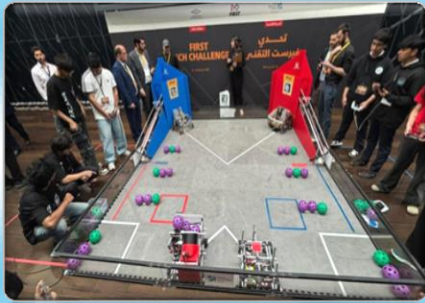
