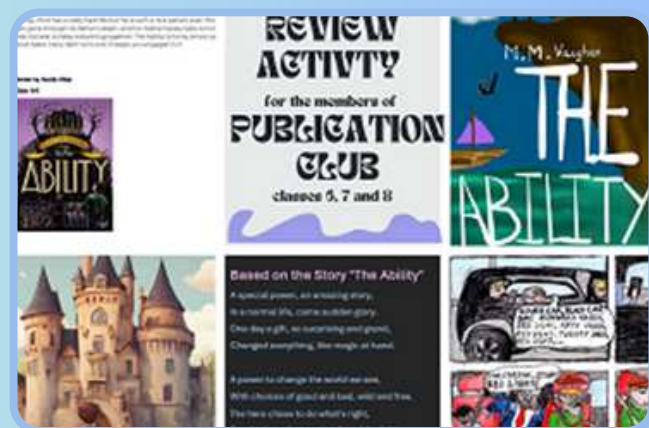

BOOK REVIEW PUBLICATION CLUB ACTIVITY 2024-25



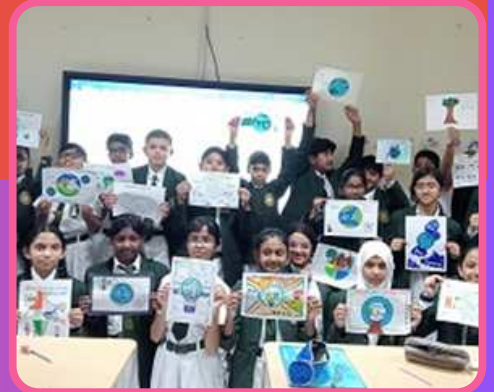

THE MATHEMATICS CLUB

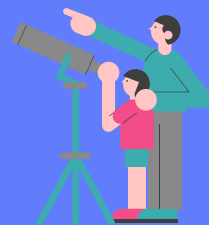

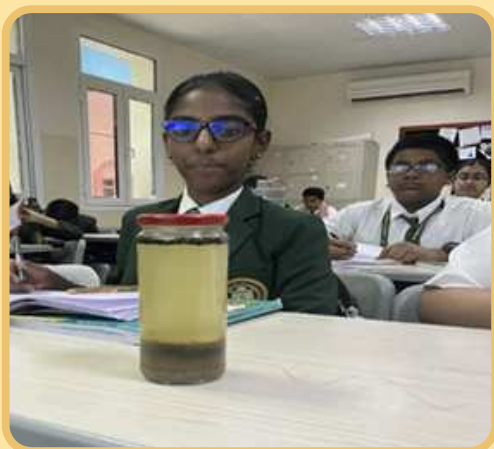


ACTIVITIES CORNER

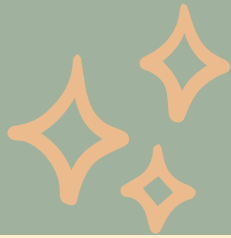
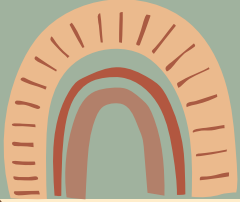

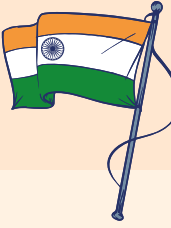
