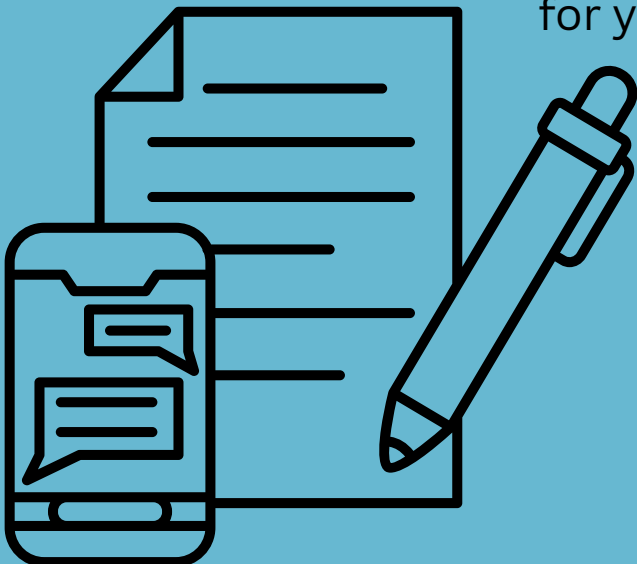

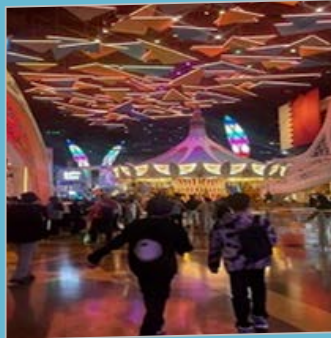


DPS-Modern Indian School Qatar Hosts Session on Exam Stress Management 2024-25

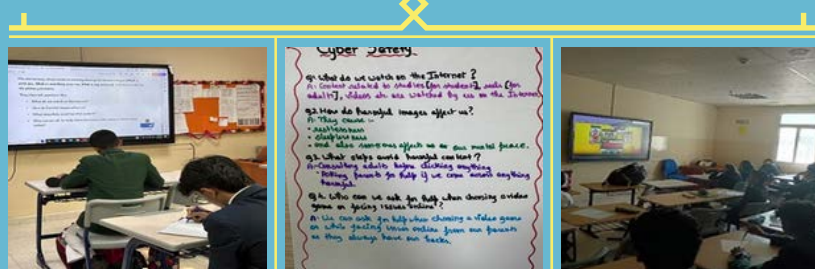


GRADE VII - MY VALUE SHAPE MY IDENTITY

Children's Day Celebrations 2024



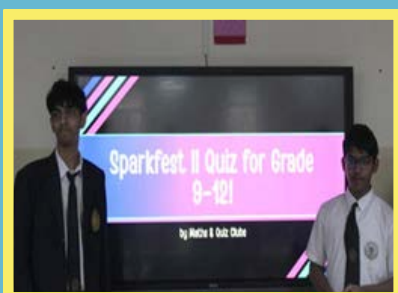

Spark Fest 2024 – 25

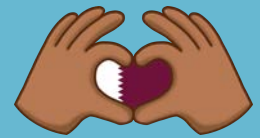

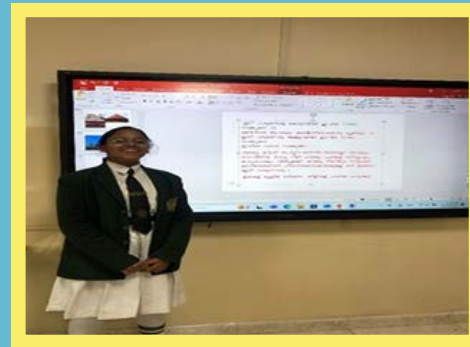

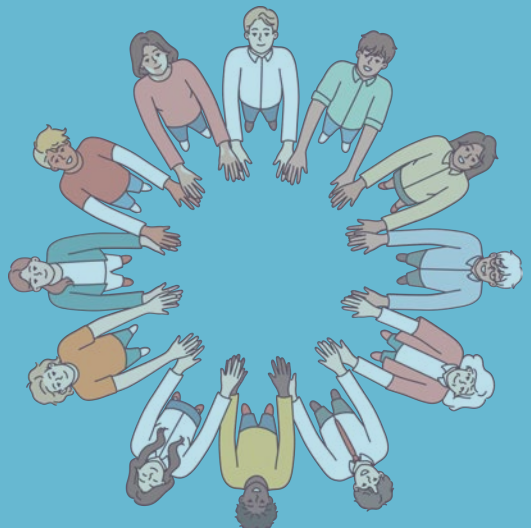
SPELL BEE

QATAR NATIONAL DAY ASSEMBLY BY CLASS 7F AND 7G

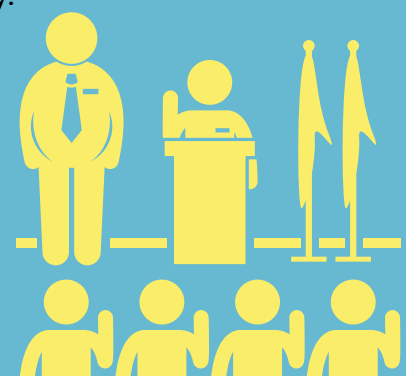

BULLETIN BOARD

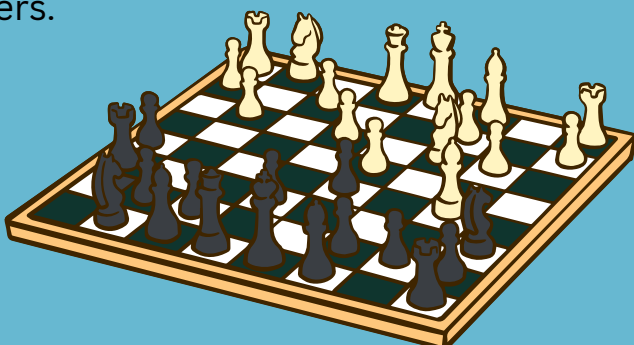
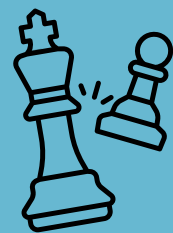
