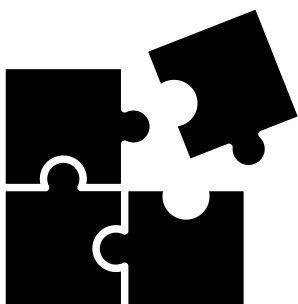

Viswa Hindi Diwas Celebration 2026

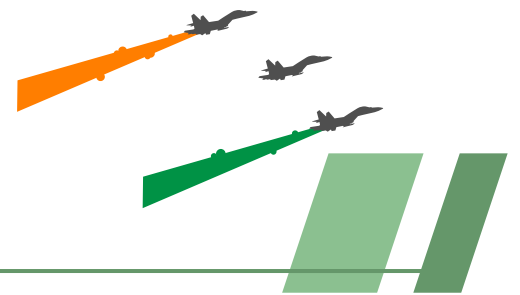
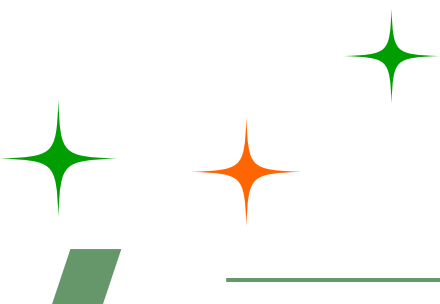

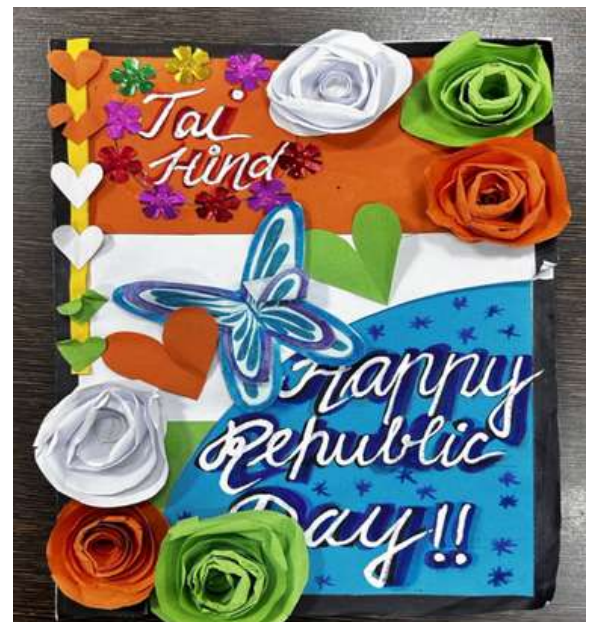
National constitutional day was celebrated at DPS-MODERN INDIAN SCHOOL to commemorate the adoption of the Indian Constitution.

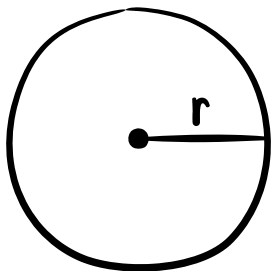
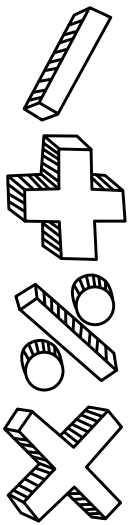
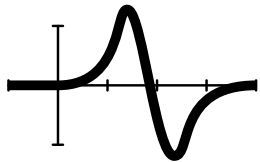
